Content migration (I)


The main unit is the Confluence space, migrated from the **space zip export** 

Pages and attachments  with **history**, **blog posts** , **comments**, **annotations**  are included

Spaces become page trees in XWiki, **hierarchy and order of pages**  is preserved; parent of the space page trees can be configured on migration

Page **favorites** , **labels**  (tags) and **space templates** are migrated to XWiki

Page and space **permissions**  are migrated and converted into XWiki access rules

Tasks  from Confluence pages are migrated to XWiki Task Manager (Pro) entries

A tool is available to migrate the **groups**  with their members in XWiki

A tool is available to migrate **calendars**  into XWiki Calendar (Pro)

Content migration (II)
